



BANT MEMBER ADMISSIONS POLICY TO THE END OF DECEMBER 2010

The external regulation of nutritional therapy practitioners has now been transferred to the Complementary and Natural Healthcare Council (CNHC): www.cnhc.org.uk.

BANT membership admission policy will be reviewed at end of December 2010.

Currently anyone wishing to apply for BANT membership should be guided by the following:

(a) Student Membership

Any student of a training provider whose course is being accredited by the NTC may be a student member of BANT.

(b) Upgrade from Student to Full Membership

Graduates from training providers who were previously approved by BANT (*) can apply to have their membership upgraded to full membership as long as they had student membership of BANT during this time. Students graduating from training providers other than those listed (*) but which are currently members of the NTC Schools Forum can only transfer to full membership if their course has been fully accredited or they are registered with the CNHC.

(c) Full Membership

Applications are accepted from any graduates of a formerly approved BANT course (*) who completed their course during the dates that the training providers were recognised. We will also accept applications from those who are listed on the NTC website or CNHC register.
